Today, Walter B. Hoye II, Founder and President of the **California Civil Rights Foundation**, requested Title and Summary from the Office of the Attorney General for the **California Human Rights Amendment**.

The **California Civil Rights Foundation** is set to begin its campaign to recognize the rights of every human being in the State of California. “The **California Human Rights Amendment** recognizes the inherent human rights, dignity and worth of all human beings

from the beginning of their biological development as human organisms – regardless of the means by which they were procreated, method of reproduction, age, race, sex, gender, physical well-being, function, or condition of physical or mental dependency and/or disability,” stated Hoye.
